### Excursions

- Niagara Falls: cruise on board the Maid of the Mist (**entrance included**), Queen Victoria Park, fireworks over the falls.

**One half-day excursion by public transit and assistance from native speaking staff:**

- Hockey Hall of Fame (**entrance included**) explore Canada's favorite pastime; CF Toronto Eaton Centre.

**Three-days/Two-Night miniBreak in Ottawa** in a hotel/ university residence with standard services and half board: Parliament Hill; Peace Tower, Centennial Flame, Changing of the Guard ceremony; Canadian Royal Mounted Police Little Italy Tour, Preston Street Murals & ByWard Market Walking Tour along the Rideau Canal: Lower Town, National Gallery of Canada, Notre Dame Basilica, Royal Canadian Mint.
